Christmas Dinner at Croydon Voluntary Action

One of our key initiatives during the year was our continued involvement in the Young People's Christmas Dinner, held at Croydon Voluntary Action (CVA) in December 2024. 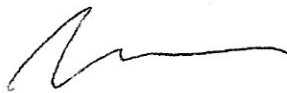
ambition and self-belief amongst participants, empowering them to envision brighter futures for themselves.

One of our key initiatives during the year was our involvement in the Young People's Christmas Dinner, held at Croydon Voluntary Action in December 2023. This event provided vulnerable children with a memorable Christmas experience, including a warm festive meal and Christmas gifts. The initiative aimed to ensure that these young people felt included and valued during the holiday season, creating positive memories and a sense of belonging. In March 2024, the Charles Gordon Trust extended its support to vulnerable women through a donation to ANOS, an organisation dedicated to addressing violence against women and girls (VAWG). This contribution was made to support their ongoing efforts in empowering and protecting women affected by violence, further strengthening our commitment to social justice and community welfare.

Looking ahead, the Trust is in the process of launching an educational course in collaboration with Morley College. This initiative will provide young people in the community with the opportunity to attend university and study business-related courses. The goal is to equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge to pursue entrepreneurship, fostering economic independence and innovation among the next generation.

Additionally, we are in the planning stages of organising the Golden Lion Awards 2025, an event designed to recognize and celebrate community heroes and organisations across London and the UK. This prestigious event will highlight the invaluable contributions of individuals and groups who are dedicated to supporting the community and keeping young people off the streets.

The Charles Gordon Trust remains steadfast in its mission to create positive change within the community. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to our partners, supporters, and

The Charles Gordon Trust charity aims to promote social inclusion and to provide support to those who are socially and/or economically disadvantaged. The charity aims to assist individuals in the community in relation to mentorship, homelessness and loneliness, provide support for the youth and young entrepreneurs in relation to setting up businesses and receiving business grants, as well as to support families and children in the cost of living crisis.

For Black History Month 2022, the charity organized a dinner hosting Marcus Garvey's son, Dr Julius Garvey. This dinner was arranged to celebrate black history month and the life of Marcus Garvey.

The Trust also assisted with facilitating a relationship between a food supplier and a local school in Lewisham, namely Rushey Green Primary School, to supply 200 frozen meals to the families of the underprivileged children in the school, to support them over the school holiday period. The charity continues to work on a long-term plan with the supplier, to facilitate regular donations of frozen meals to families of underprivileged children across schools in Lewisham and Croydon.

In late 2023, The Charles Gordon Trust raised funds to support community organisations and young people in the borough of Croydon; the charity was approached by a community leader in the borough of Croydon, to provide meals for 120 young people who were participating in an anti-knife crime football community event, at the Crystal Palace Football Stadium.

The Charity is also working on developing a course for further and higher education, for those who do not have access to such courses through standard educational institutions. This will facilitates gaps in learning and education that many individuals face in boroughs such as Croydon and Lewisham, giving people an opportunity to develop their skills and increase their employability and opportunities.

The Charles Gordon Trust charity aims to promote social inclusion and to provide support to those who are socially and/or economically disadvantaged. The charity aims to assist individuals in the community in relation to mentorship, homelessness and loneliness, provide support for the youth and young entrepreneurs in relation to setting up businesses and receiving business grants, as well as to support families and children in the cost of living crisis.

In 2021, The Charles Gordon Trust raised funds for two important initiatives in relation to the education of young people; the charity was approached by a philanthropist in the community who was aware of a school in need of laptops for their pupils, to assist them with their learning and with progression in their IT skills. As a result, the trust raised funds which, on 13th December 2021, were donated to the South Norwood Primary School in Croydon.

The Trust also assisted with raising funds to go towards a toddler's Christmas party in Perivale, where some of the children were observed to be in need of winter items such as socks and coats and winter clothing.

In April 2022, the Charles Gordon Trust organised an event in the Croydon borough whereby grass-roots organisations, young people, businesses, individuals, community groups and more were awarded and celebrated for their good work in the community. 500 members of the Croydon community attended the event and over 4000 other people through positive initiatives and messaging on social media. The Trust is now organising a national awards and recognition event in 2023, which will see more individuals and organisations who are doing good work for the community, rewarded and recognised for their efforts.

The Charity is also working on developing a project to provide school meals to 300 children in 2 boroughs in London, who are experiencing hunger whilst at school due to the cost-of-living crisis and the financial strains placed on their parents. The charity aims to launch this project imminently for 6 months to begin, and then run for the whole of the next school year. This project is being developed on the back of a headteacher speaking up in the borough of Lewisham, whereby she observed pupils stealing food from their peers due to hunger and eating rubbers to stop feeling hungry.
