Para 1.20	The future of the sport of Real Tennis depends on equipping apprentices with a range of transferable skills that will enable them to take up managerial positions in sports clubs. Such a training benefits not just the apprentices themselves but all amateur players of real tennis many of whom continue to play until well into their seventies and even eighties, for their own and the wider health of society. In its first year of operation the club has donated £40,000 to the Tennis and Rackets Association to be spent specifically in the training of four apprentices. As a direct result of that donation, one of those trainees has already found full time employment in a sports club.
