Report of the Trustees

The Trustees have pleasure in presenting the annual report and accounts for the charity for the year ended 31 July 2025.

1 Objectives and activities

The primary activity of the charity is supporting people with an unplanned pregnancy, or following on from an abortion.

2 Achievements and performance

During this year, the Pregnancy Crisis Helpline received 1400 calls and 325 messages from clients requesting support - 1725 in total.

Our Google Ads were shown 210,000 times and people clicked on those adverts 8,200 times.

The trustee team agreed a new partnership with Sheffield Pregnancy Counselling Support to expand the number of volunteers available to support clients.

The operations team met monthly to share expertise and embed best-practices across all the partner centres. They also implemented termly meetings for all the partnership team volunteers to support continuous professional development.

One of our partners closed their local helpline to consolidate the resources into the PCH national helpline.

An external advisor performed a full audit of our technology platform, concluding that it was performing as expected.

Safeguarding and data protection continued to be a core focus of our operational and governance oversight.

We secured £13,500 in donations and £27,500 in grants during the year, a significant increase on the previous year, and met with numerous organisations and individuals for fundraising support.

We created a Case for Support document and a promotional video to give potential supporters an overview of the charity.

Toby Cosh, who is a trustee for the charity, continued to cover the interim CEO role until sufficient funds can be raised to formally advertise and appoint a permanent CEO. (NB: This is permitted by the charity's constitution).

3 Financial review

There was a surplus of £3,975 on general funds during the year (2024: deficit of £3,786).

4 Structure, governance and management

The Trust is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation, charity number 1190460, and was registered with the Charity Commission in 2020.

4 Related party transactions

During this period, website services were provided to the Pregnancy Crisis Helpline by Narkan Ltd, a company for which Toby Cosh is owner and director. However during this year no invoices were submitted. (In 2024, total services of £1,282 were provided, of which £360 were reimbursements for payments made on behalf of the charity and £922 was for website services provided by Narkan Ltd to PCH).

During the year Trustee Toby Cosh was paid a salary of £25,478 and the charity made employer pension contributions for Mr Cosh of £764 in relation to his employment as the part-time interim CEO for Pregnancy Crisis Helpline.

Report of the Trustees

The Trustees have pleasure in presenting the annual report and accounts for the charity for the year ended 31 July 2024.

1 Objectives and activities

The primary activities of the charity is supporting people with an unplanned pregnancy, or following on from an abortion.

2 Achievements and performance

The Helpline received approximately 1,500 contacts from clients during this period.

The charity finalised its partnership agreement with two other pregnancy support charities - Image (Manchester) and Options (London). This will increase the number of volunteers available to respond to the calls and messages received by the PCH Helpline, which at present exceed the capacity of the Helpline.

A very experienced Team Coordinator joined the charity to help oversee the team and training. They will support the CEO with strengthening and growing the charity and coordinating the partnership teams, to ensure Helpline clients receive consistent, high-quality support during every call, and to enable the charity to support increasing numbers of clients.

All safeguarding procedures and policies were reviewed and updated by an specialist external safeguarding agency.

Extensive and ongoing fundraising work was done to secure funding for the charity.

The volunteer team attended safeguarding, data protection and cyber security training sessions. They also received training on trauma-informed practice as part of a continuing professional development programme.

An experienced supervisor was appointed to ensure the team receives regular support sessions, to develop their practice and keep them healthy and supported.

Ongoing work with the data protection officer further strengthened the charity's processes and policies.

The charity appointed an additional safeguarding officer who is very experienced in working with vulnerable people.

The Charity Commission completed a review of PCH and was happy with the governance and compliance of the charity.

2 Achievements and performance (continued)

Toby Cosh, who is currently a trustee for the charity, had been covering the CEO role voluntarily in the short term until sufficient funds could be raised to formally advertise and appoint a permanent CEO. Since September he has received a part-time salary for this role, as permitted by the charity's constitution.

3 Financial review

There was a deficit of £3,786 on general funds during the year (2023: surplus of £13,306).

4 Structure, governance and management

The Trust is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation, charity number 1190460, and was registered with the Charity Commission in 2020.

The trustees have pleasure in presenting the annual report and accounts for the charity for the year ended 31 July 2023.

1 Objectives and activities

The primary activities of the charity is supporting people with an unplanned pregnancy, or following on from an abortion.

2 Achievements and performance

During the past year we have built on the achievements of the previous year, as follows:

PCH has had another busy and successful year. We responded to 2005 calls and 605 web chat messages.

Relationships with partner organisations have continued to strengthen, and have borne fruit in two main areas. Firstly, helpline volunteers have undergone specialist accredited training with one of these organisations. Secondly, one of the organisations was able to handle a significant number of calls to the helpline, resulting in more clients receiving an immediate response when calling the helpline. The next step is to further increase call-handling capacity to meet the needs of callers.

On the administrative side, we have revised and added a number of policies, appointed an experienced data protection officer, and are in the process of creating tailored safeguarding guidance for the team, in collaboration with a team of safeguarding professionals. Fundraising has continued to present a challenge, but the trustees are in the process of strategising how to raise significant funds to enable the charity to grow to meet demand.

The last year has also seen the introduction of regular training meetings with volunteers and trustees, and also regular case review meetings for volunteers with an experienced accredited counsellor.

Two of our trustees stepped down from the role during the course of the year, but we have established a team of expert advisors for the trustees to consult on issues such as legal, HR, executive management, safeguarding, data protection, counselling and psychotherapy, and fundraising

1 Objectives and activities

The primary activities of the charity is supporting people with an unplanned pregnancy, or following on from an abortion.

2 Achievements and performance

During the past year we have built on the achievements of the previous year, as follows:

More volunteers have been recruited to cover the helpline, and have received specialist training from one of our partner organizations;

New trustees have been appointed with specialist skills in counselling and psychotherapy;

We have developed relations with other, similar organisations, allowing us to transfer calls to volunteers from those organisations;

A renewed commitment to fundraising has resulted in significant donations from organisations who share our objectives;

Our social media presence has increased significantly on platforms including Facebook and Instagram, and we have created a supporters' website;

We have instituted a programme of active supervision, support and ongoing training/development of our volunteers to ensure that they provide the best possible service to callers;

The trustees reaffirmed the Charity's Christian ethos by adopting a statement of faith.

There was a deficit of £4,845 on general funds during the year (2021: Surplus of £5,643)





Report of the Trustees

The trustees have pleasure in presenting the annual report and accounts for the charity for the first period ended 31 July 2021

1 Objectives and activities

The primary activities of the charity is supporting people with an unplanned pregnancy, or following on from an abortion.

2 Achievements and performance

During the past year of starting work as a charity and piloting the Helpline systems, the Board has celebrated a number of achievements.

Over the course of the year 14 volunteers have been recruited and either trained or in training, and the charity has provided a service to approximately 500 callers.

The appointment of four trustees including the Chair was finalised and it was formally agreed by the Board to engage Regan King as the charity's Chief Executive, effective from 20th July 2021.

The charity's key technology was set up, including the helpline which utilises the RingCentral digital phone system to allow for remote call-handling across our volunteer base, a website, Google Ads, and ZenDesk which allows for web-chat capability.

The Board has established the charity's purpose and ethos through the drafting of its constitution and the creation of its Guiding Principles document, which is to be referred to by all Board members, staff and volunteers. It is in the process of agreeing a fundraising and growth strategy, with plans to hold charity launch events in the near future. Two patrons have been appointed, and a few others are being approached.

3 Financial review

There was a surplus of £5,643 on general funds over the period.

4 Structure, governance and management

The Trust is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation, charity number 1190460, and was registered with the Charity Commission in 2020.
