Objectives and Activities

Wings and Paws Rescue continues its mission to rescue, rehabilitate and rehome sick, neglected and abandoned animals across the West Midlands and Shropshire. As a non-profit, volunteer-led organisation under the leadership of CEO Clare Vowles, our dedicated team works tirelessly to provide safety and second chances to animals of every age, breed and background.

Alongside domestic rescue, we remain committed to caring for local wildlife in need, offering treatment, rehabilitation and release whenever possible. Our belief is simple: every animal deserves compassion, protection and the opportunity to thrive, and we are honoured to deliver that care each day.

Achievements and Performance

2025 has been a year marked by extraordinary teamwork, community support and unforgettable rescue stories.

In August, we proudly hosted our 5th Annual Funday, which proved to be our most successful event yet. Held at Bradshaws Doggy Paddocks, the day brought together families, adopters, supporters and volunteers, raising an incredible £4,261.50 for the animals in our care. The atmosphere was filled with joy, compassion and community spirit, and we are immensely grateful to everyone who attended, donated or helped bring the day to life.

Another major focus this year has been supporting a local feral cat colony. Through patient and persistent trapping, neutering and returning of the adult cats, we are working to reduce the number of kittens being born into unsafe conditions. This long-term effort is vital in preventing suffering and ensuring healthier, more manageable colonies for years to come.

Among the most memorable cases of 2025 was little Devon, a tiny puppy who arrived in a heartbreaking condition. Suffering from a severe case of The Strangles, his skin was inflamed, painful and incredibly fragile, with his ears and eyes affected badly. Thanks to immediate veterinary intervention, round-the-clock care and the dedication of his foster family, Devon made a full recovery. He is now thriving in his forever home, a testament to what love and proper care can achieve.

Easter weekend brought one of our most dramatic rescues to date. Four neglected ponies and a young foal were signed over to the charity, setting off a frantic thirty-hour operation involving emergency transport, late-night coordination and a race across the country to bring them to safety. By Sunday evening, all five horses were settled into secure care. Shortly afterwards, a second foal was born, bringing hope and new beginnings to a situation that had started in such distress.

These cases highlight the heart of what Wings and Paws Rescue stands for: stepping in when no one else can, and ensuring every animal has the chance to be safe, loved and understood.

Our work continues to be possible only through the generosity and kindness of our supporters and local community. Every donation, fundraiser, shared post and kind word allows us to provide essential supplies, veterinary treatment, food, comfort and safety to the animals who need us most. We remain deeply grateful for the trust placed in us and the unwavering belief in our mission.



Objectives and activities

Wings and Paws Rescue is dedicated to rescuing, rehabilitating, and finding loving homes for sick, neglected, and abandoned animals across the West Midlands and Shropshire. As a non-profit, volunteer-led organisation under the leadership of CEO Clare Vowles and our passionate team of animal lovers, we welcome animals of all ages, health conditions, sexes, and breeds. We firmly believe that every animal deserves a chance at a loving home, and we work tirelessly to make that vision a reality.

In addition to domestic animal rescue, we care for injured local wildlife, providing rehabilitation and ultimately returning them to their natural habitats.

Achievements and Performance

This year, a significant part of our efforts focused on assisting individuals and families struggling financially due to ongoing economic challenges. From providing essential supplies such as dog food to offering financial support for flea treatments, wormers, and other veterinary care, our aim was to prevent families from having to part with their cherished pets. This was particularly notable in our help, early on in the year, to help owners of XL bullies complete their exemption registrations during a very difficult time for them. The cost and stress of potentially losing their beloved pet was heartbreaking and we did all we could to support them both emotionally and financially.

In August, we hosted our 4th Annual Fun Day, and it exceeded all expectations. With more attendees and activities than ever before, we raised over £3,700 to support the animals in our care. A focal point of the funday was an emphasis on "big is beautiful" encouraging registered owners of XL Bullies to come along and show off this fantastic breed.

Among our most heartwarming cases of the year was Stella, an 18-month-old French Bulldog surrendered after her owner was unwilling to pay for an emergency caesarean on Easter Sunday. We covered the cost of the operation and the vet fees and took them all into our care. Stella nurtured her four beautiful puppies, and all five dogs have since found their happily ever afters. Another unforgettable moment came when Marcel, a marmoset monkey, wandered into a local home. His story captivated the nation and was featured in local and national newspapers as well as many radio stations. With the unwavering care of Clare and the volunteers, he was lucky enough to find his forever home at Monkey World in Dorset.

Our work is only possible thanks to the unwavering generosity of our supporters and community. Every donation directly funds essential resources, including food, veterinary expenses, blankets, toys, and other critical supplies for the animals. We are deeply grateful for the compassion and kindness shown by everyone who contributes to our mission.



Objectives and activities.

Wings and Paws Rescue, a registered charity in Wolverhampton, is committed to rescuing, nurturing, and finding loving homes for ailing, neglected, and abandoned animals across the West Midlands and Shropshire. We are a non-profit volunteer-driven animal rescue organisation led by CEO Clare Vowles and her devoted team of volunteer animal enthusiasts. We do not discriminate on age, health, sex or breed, in our opinion all animals deserve a loving home and this is what we strive to provide.

We also take care of any local wildlife that is injured, rehabilitating and then returning them to the wild.

Achievements and performance

This year we were named as one of The Mayor of Wolverhampton's chosen charities.

We held our 3rd annual Fun Day in August and it was a massive success, even bigger and better than the previous years, the day raised over £6,000 for the animals in our care! Even the Mayor and the Mayoress attended!

Two big cases of the year were Dexter, the tiny 5 month old Dachshund puppy who was so neglected and emaciated he weighed the equivalent of a 3 month old puppy. Medically nothing was wrong with him, it was simply the sad case of his previous owner starving him. Dexter has now found his forever home and will be joining them soon..

We also had Major, Ingrid and their puppies, who were given into our care by West Midlands Police after they were seized from a flat where they were kept in horrendous conditions. Major belonged to a homeless man who had sadly passed away and Wings and Paws were his registered owner on the microchip having helped his owner take care of him in the past. Ingrid and her puppies have all now been rehomed and Major is staying on as a permanent foster with CEO Clare as they have such a strong bond.

This year a main focus has been helping people who are struggling financially, as the current crisis is hitting hard. Sometimes this has simply involved dropping dog food to them to see them through to payday, other times we've paid for flea/wormer or other vet treatments to ensure that families don't needlessly lose their beloved pets.

We rely solely on the kindness of our supporters and community. All donations that are received go direct towards food, vet bills, blankets, toys and other pet supplies.

Financial review

The year to 31 March 2023 showed an unrestricted fund of £5048 being the bank balance at that date.

Objectives and activities.

Wings and Paws Animal Rescue specializes in the rescue and placement of abused, unwanted and abandoned animals. We never discriminate on the basis of health, age or breed. We show kindness and try to prevent or suppress cruelty to animals. We make the provision of veterinary care and treatment available. We offer care and re-homing to animals that are abandoned, mistreated or lost.

Achievements and performance

We have had a successful year in terms of achievements:

We have helped over 43 cats, 22 rabbits & guinea pigs, 46 dogs, 31 birds, 56 hamsters, mice & rats, 10 sheep, 2 goats, 3 pigs, 3 horses, 5 tortoises, 3 snakes, 4 bearded dragons and a geko many of which are now in their forever homes.

One of our big achievements has been the rescue and treatment of Rupert the French Bulldog who came to us with IVDD (a severe spinal condition). His owners were going to have him put to sleep as they could not afford the £7k+ vet bill and were reluctant to hand him over to a rescue. Luckily the vets talked them round and he was signed over to us. Rupert has surgery the following day at West Midlands Referral Vets and after a long but successful recovery process and lots of Physio and Hydrotherapy Rupert is now in his forever foster home.

Another was Walter the Dachshund, who again came to us after his breeder took him to be put to sleep. Walter had a broken jaw and was only around 5-6 weeks old. We're unsure how the injury happened but we suspect mistreatment. Walter couldn't eat or drink on his own and had to be syringe fed and spent a couple of days & nights in the care of the vets. He then came to us and was placed in a very experienced foster home to be hand reared while his treatment was looked into. Again we sought the help of West Midlands Referral Vets to operated on. He had 2 pins screwed into his jaw and was then on the long road to recovery. He is now fully healed and with his new adoptive family.

We have had great exposure in the local newspaper again, as well as on the local radio station. Both media's promoted our 2nd annual Funday and the Express & Star has featured several of our animals looking for a very special type of home. Stevie the cat and Nancy the French Bulldog are two such animals who found their homes thanks to their help. Our website has continued to grow and is a large part of our rescue now.

As mentioned, we organised and ran a 2nd successful dog show in the summer, this year attracted even more visitors than last year and was a huge success.

We have also this year taken on more reptiles this year than ever before, as we're finding the rise in living costs are resulting in people being unable to afford the cost of keeping them.

Wings and Paws Animal Rescue specializes in the rescue and placement of abused, unwanted and abandoned animals. We never discriminate on the basis of health, age or breed. We show kindness and try to prevent or suppress cruelty to animals. We make the provision of veterinary care and treatment available. We offer care and re-homing to animals that are abandoned, mistreated or lost.

Achievements and performance

We have had a successful year in terms of achievements:

45 Cats have been rescued, treated neutered and re-homed

28 Kittens have been rescued, treated neutered and re-homed

27 dogs have been rescued, treated neutered and re-homed

We have 4 dogs that will stay in long term foster due to the complex medical needs and we have 3 cats in long term foster for their medical needs.

One of our biggest achievements has been the relocation of 52 Feral cats, that were living on the motorway. This was very dangerous for the cats along with drivers. It has taken us 12 months to catch, treat and neuter all 52 and then successfully re locate them to feral holdings, and farms across the country.

We have had 2 major success stories, the first being a dog called Isabella, she was a puppy when she came to us and unfortunately, she was paralysed. However, after consulting with the vet we put a plan in place to try different methods to get her walking again. This was successful, and now Isabella is a happy mobile dog who is now in her forever home.

Teddy came to us with a heart murmur. After consultation with the vet we decided to operate and luckily for us he made it through. He has now fully recovered and has been rehomed to his forever home.

We have had great exposure in the local newspaper, earlier this year we appeared doing a show and tell like story of who we are and what we do, we have also launched a new website which gives our followers and supporters a place to see the work we do and any events that we have planned. It also gives people needing our help a contact form along with some useful information.

We organised and ran a successful dog show last summer, an event that attracted a large amount of visitors and was a great family day out. We hope to continue on this road now that Covid restrictions are reduced.
