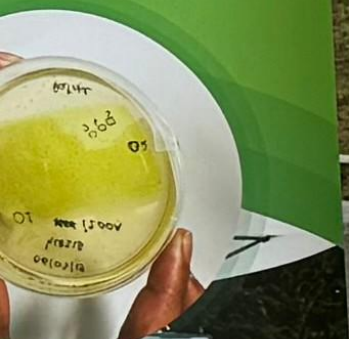

**FINANCIAL YEAR IN REVIEW**



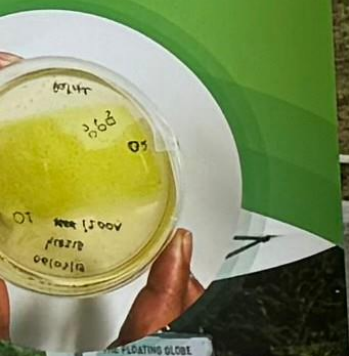


Thanks to the introduction of contactless donations we've been able to cater to a wider range of potential donors. Something which was lacking in our past efforts.
