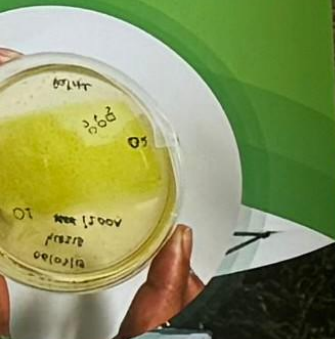

FINANCIAL YEAR IN REVIEW


