Due to his older age and travel restrictions, we couldn't visit England and start the operations of the Trust as intended. Therefore, this financial year, the CIO could not initiate its operations.

In October 2024, I visited the UK to start operations. Following this, Mr. Gul Ahmed passed away, and Mr. Nisar Yousuf Bawany resigned for personal reasons. Mr. Muhammad Tahir and Mr. Muhammad Afzal joined the organization as Trustees. We attempted to open a bank account, and I visited in May 2025 to facilitate this process. Unfortunately, despite completing the necessary documents, changes to the bank's portal rendered our efforts unsuccessful. We are currently in the process of opening the account again. Once this is completed, we can commence our operations.
