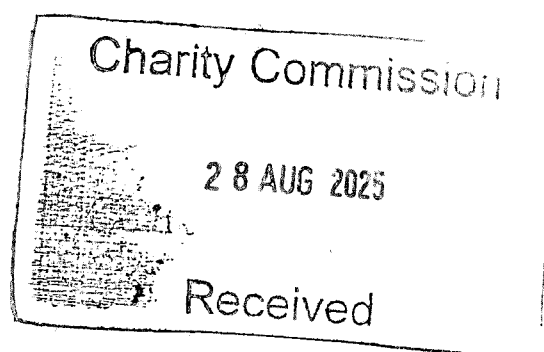

Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 30 June 2024

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2024. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The objects of the charitable company are as follows:

We provide mentor and mentee services free of charge to help people in the property industry improve their mental health and wellbeing and to support them to achieve their life objectives. Our support brings together a mentor who engages with the mentee, normally over a six month period to help guide them and to provide betterment and relief from what might otherwise be a hardship they would be left to endure alone. We are wholly focussed on delivering services and resources to those in the UK property market and working in partnership with our 300 Volunteers to best serve the people who may be facing adversity.

Significant activities

The trustees have confirmed that they have referred to the guidance in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future activities and setting the expenditure policy for the year.

Public benefit

The charitable organisations main activities are facilitated by its website and social media channels. This includes the highly accoladed mentorship programme, free training and resource provision and valuable free content to assist in the betterment of the people.

To date the mentorship programme alone has now delivered over 55,000 hours of mentoring support, thanks to the support of over 300-400 volunteers over 1500 people have gained assistance.

Further, the charitable organisation has worked with and engaged strategic partners to deliver training and free to access mental health resources for all.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

We continue to develop our offering at pace whilst maintaining a steady cost base YOY.

We have recruited hundreds of new volunteers who continue to assist in the overall objective of improving enterprise skills and reducing hardship. We have acknowledged and developed a training need to ensure that our growing volunteer network are best placed to support our community.

Further, we have established "working groups" within our community to further assist us in the development and delivery of our support. This has then resulted in the creation and launch of numerous new initiatives including a new website that provides training, downloadable guides and resources particularly relevant to reduce mental hardship

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

During the period the charity received £77,500 in donations and expended £89,418 on achieving its charitable objectives.

Principal funding sources

The principal funding source of the charity is donations received.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

It is the charitable company's policy to hold little or no reserves. All income is to be expended on its charitable objectives.

The amount of reserves held at 30 June 2024 was a liability of £28,392 (2022 liability - £16,474).

Going concern

During October 2024 the charitable activities were ceased due to the death of the charity's managing trustee and funding being withdrawn by the main donor. After due consideration of the charity's financial position, its reserves and future cashflow projections, the trustees concluded that it was no longer appropriate to prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis.

The decision was made in October 2024 to cease charitable activities and to begin the process of winding up the charity.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity was established under a deed of trust, dated 5 June 2020, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

Membership is open to other individuals or organisations who are approved by the directors.

Decision making

The trustees aim to meet at least every six months. They guide the direction of the charity and ensure that it is being run effectively.

Day to day running of the charitable company has been delegated by the trustees to Ms Kerrie Humphrys. Sadly the Chief Executive Officer Sarah Edmundson passed away during October 2024. Kerrie is now responsible for reviewing and sanctioning all transactions.

Induction and training of new trustees

New trustees receive copies of all relevant trust documents and of the Charity Commission guidance. Appropriate training is organised for the trustees.

Key management remuneration

Per the charitable companies articles of association a director may receive a benefit from the charity in the capacity of a beneficiary of the charity provided that a majority of the directors do not benefit in this way. There are currently no employees subject of remuneration.

Remuneration of the charitable company's key management is set by the trustee's based on the market rate for the work being undertaken.




The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of its financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2024 in accordance with Section 476 of the Companies Act 2006.

Notes to the Financial Statements for the Year Ended 30 June 2024

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The charitable company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the charitable company's pension scheme are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.

Going concern

The financial statements have not been prepared on a going concern basis. The trustees have concluded that the charity is no longer a going concern due to the death of the managing trustee and the withdrawal of funding from the charity's main donor. The charity ceased operations in October 2024.

As such, the financial statements have been prepared on a break-up basis. This involves adjusting the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities to reflect the amounts expected to be recovered or settled in the course of winding up,
