The club relocated during September 2024 to newer premises with a reduction in rent.

Training has been adjusted as follows:

Juniors (to age 12/13) Monday & Wednesdays 5pm to 6pm

Seniors (12/13 +) Monday & Wednesday Evenings 6.30pm to 8pm

Additional sessions for carded boxers on Friday's 6.30pm to 8pm

The club has also seen growth in numbers and strong retention, with many now having moved to a monthly rolling membership basis rather than pay as you go.

There has been an increase in carded/competitive boxers to circa around 10 ahead of the upcoming season, many of whom are looking to also compete in box cup and national championships, which is inspiring to other members.

We have regular sparring sessions with other local clubs which our youngsters really look forward to.

She originally came to the club with a friend following our reopening after lockdown with no aspirations as to what she wanted from attending. It soon became apparent that she had a natural ability which gave her the confidence to improve.

Several of our other boxers have had successes at various boxing shows and it certainly inspires the other members.

We have regular sparring sessions with other local clubs which our youngsters really look forward to.

As well as other clubs visiting us we also travel to other clubs to give our boxers the opportunity to see how other clubs are run.
