The prevention or relief of poverty in Pakistan in particular but not exclusively by, providing or assisting in the provision of; clean water supply, food, clothing, medical care, equipment for disabled people, education for orphans.

In setting our objectives and planning our activities our trustees have given careful consideration to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

Since its beginning, Al-Qiyas Welfare has been supporting families who have lost loved ones in arranging funerals and burial. This year again, we have provided financial help to families in need and provided essential packs with necessary items including the shroud (kafan) for burial according to Islamic tradition.

Just like previous years, this year again Al-Qiyas Welfare provided monthly food packs to those in need throughout the year. In particular, food packs were distributed to families in the Islamic month of Ramadan. Over 300 families benefitted from our food packs which included up to one month's supply of essential food items to feed a family in need.

Also, hot cooked meals were distributed free to adults and children in need who were homeless or living on the streets.

This year we helped provide medicines to cancer patients.

More people in Pakistan benefitted from free clothes and shoes that were generously donated by people in the UK. Pakistani clothing, jumpers, coats, jackets and shoes were distributed to men, women and children in need.

Warm clothes for the winter season were distributed in a residential home in Jhelum, Pakistan. The residents included old people and those with disabilities or learning difficulties who have no loved ones or anyone to care for them.

This Eid al-Adha 2022 Qurbani meat was distributed to over 300 families in Jhelum, Pakistan.

This year, over 300 families benefitted from food packs; Qurbani meat was distributed to over 350 families.

We have continued to support families who lose loved ones by providing financial help for funeral and burial according to Islamic tradition as well as providing free essential packs with necessary items including the shroud (kafan).

Also, this year, Al-Qiyas Welfare helped provide medication to patients suffering from cancer.


