The objects of the charity as set out in the governing document

For the benefit of the public to promote the conservation, protection and improvement of the natural and physical environment to mitigate the effects of climate change by:

- a) protecting, restoring and promoting sustainable use of ecosystems worldwide;
 - b) restoring fragile ecosystems where degradation has taken place by rehabilitation of the natural environment for example by planting trees, restoring grassland, protecting river banks and water catchment areas
 - c) conserving and sustainable use of the oceans, seas and marine resources;
 - d) conserving endangered native species of fauna and flora to promote biological diversity;
 - e) educating about the effects of climate change, ways to prevent and mitigate climate change and live sustainably;
 - f) promoting and funding research into climate change, the useful results of which will be disseminated to the public at large.
- 2) To promote sustainable development for the benefit of the public by:
- a) the preservation, conservation and the protection of the environment and the prudent use of resources;
 - b) the relief of poverty and the improvement of the conditions of life in socially and economically disadvantaged communities;
 - c) the promotion of sustainable means of achieving economic growth and regeneration.

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TRUSTEES' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30th September 2025

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

During the 2024/25 financial year, the Trustees of Sustainable Climate followed up on talks, which had begun in 2023/24, with Eden:People+Planet. Sustainable Climate's vision was to fund an Indigenous Tree Nursery in the Loita Hills in Kenya using Eden's expertise in large scale landscape restoration. The concept was to grow seedlings from seeds sourced from the nearby Forest and use them to restore areas that had suffered from deforestation. The Nursery would provide much needed employment and training and ultimately would be used as a prototype to roll out other nurseries in the wider area adjoining the Forest.

A donation of £27,000 was made to Eden in August to fund the Nursery set up and the initial running costs. This donation immediately unlocked some matched funding for Eden and approximately doubled the funds available.

One of our Trustees went with experts from Eden to help select a Nursery site. They also looked at potential sites for further roll out as and when funds become available for more Nurseries. All cost related to this site visit have been met directly by the Trustee involved with no costs being incurred by Sustainable Climate.

The project offers a unique opportunity to make a meaningful impact on a fragile ecosystem currently under threat, and it holds the potential for significant long-term environmental and community benefits.

Financial Review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

At the end of the year the reserves were £ 1,868.46
