8. Plans for future periods

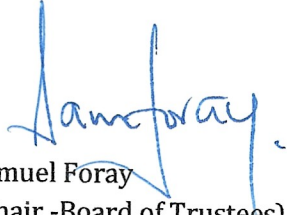
The charity will expand sustainable initiatives for women, support children's welfare, and strengthen partnerships in Formaya.
