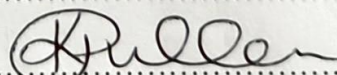

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF THE CRAIG TYLER TRUST

I report on the accounts of the Society for the year ended 31 October 2021 which are set out on pages 3 and 4.

Respective responsibilities of trustee and examiner

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts; you consider that the audit requirement of section 43(2) of the Charities Act 1993 (the Act) does not apply. Basis of independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners.
