The CIO has as yet been unable to secure a bank account due to delays caused by Covid restrictions and changes in banking regulations. This we expect to be resolved very soon.

In line with it's objects to work with other charities Maranatha International has :

Helped various communities in India and has established a partnership between Maranatha Full Gospel. Through this connection, more than 200 families have received basic help and food provision between December 2020 and March 2021

Medical support including oxygen cylinders and have also been provided.

During a trip to India visited a care home for marginalized transgender people were visited with a view to offering further counsel and to assess what helps could be offered. Food was supplied for 200 homeless beggars in the city of Chennai

Premnath Joseph, on behalf of the CIO, continues to meet with various church groups to speak about the the work and vision of Maranatha International in enriching lives.

The trustees are continuing to promote the work of the Charity, compliant with the requirements of the charity Commission and in line with current regulation.
