BACKGROUND

Vishwa Hindu Kendra (the Charity) was formed in 1976 for provision of a central place of worship in Southall and surrounding area. The Charity is a registered charity with the Charity Commission. The Charity is a membership body and its members consist of Ordinary, Associate and Life members. Membership is open to individuals who have full faith in Hinduism and the beliefs of Shri Sanatan Dharma in accordance with the requirement laid down in the Constitution. The Charity is governed by its Constitution as amended on the 9th March 1985.

PURPOSE AND PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The purpose of the Charity is to bring about the awareness of Hinduism and the philosophy of Shri Sanatan Dharma.

The Principal activities of the Charity are:

- to provide a central place of worship by Hindu Priests for performing all the religious ceremonies and to conduct public worship, prayers and rites of births, marriages and death.
- to provide guidance to those in need.
- to provide educational recreational yoga and Indian musical facilities and lectures on Hindu religion to all.

The Charity continued all its activities throughout the year.

The Charity has taken over all the assets and liabilities of Vishwa Hindu Kendra Southall, charity number 262922, as per the order dated 2 February 2021 issued by The Charity Commission for England and Wales.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Charities Act 2011, Charity SORP FRS102. The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost basis.

Income

Income is included gross, without netting off any related expenditure. Income is generally recognised when the charity becomes entitled to the resources, when receipt is probable and when the monetary amount can be measured with sufficient reliability. Specific policies relating to the charity's particular income sources are as follows:

Donations are included in the Statement of Financial Activities (SOFA) gross of any related tax reclaim.

Expenditure

Liabilities are included once the charity is under a legal or constructive obligation to transfer economic resources. Costs of charitable activities include those costs directly attributable to activities undertaken in pursuit of the charity's objects. Other expenditure includes governance costs which include all costs relating to complying with legal and regulatory requirements.

Funds structure

Unrestricted funds are those funds expendable at the discretion of the Trustees in accordance with the charitable objects. Restricted funds may only be utilised in accordance with the wishes of the donor.

Taxation

As a registered charity, it is generally exempt from income tax and capital gains tax on its charitable activities, but not from VAT. Irrecoverable VAT is included in the cost of those items to which it relates.

Trustees' emoluments

None of the trustees have received any remuneration, expenses or benefits from the charity.

Related party transactions

There have been no related party transactions in the reporting period that require disclosure.
