We did this by providing analysis of present and future matters of interest on our blog www.anglicanfutures.org/blog; offering online Ideas Exchanges enabling discussion of different topics; a regular online coffee room and regular emails to subscribers.

We have offered pastoral support to those facing difficulties in the church context, including bullying, disciplinary proceedings and loneliness of leading small churches.

We have offered practical support to church leaders seeking advice on change management, starting up charitable structures and many different aspects of church life.

In all these activities the trustees have had regard to the guidance issues by the Charity Commission on public benefit. All our activities are advertised on our website.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

By the end of 2021 we had over 280 subscribers and sent 29 emails - with an average opening rate of about 70%.

We had over 6,000 views of our blog.

We ran online Ideas Exchanges on twelve different topics - some ran several times - with an average attendance of 33 people. Over the year we reached over 200 individuals.

We have begun a regular support group for those ministering in deprived areas.

We provided a confidential in-person gathering for those concerned about the future of their Anglican denomination.

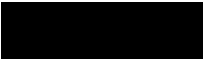
