We raise money by raffling Easter Hampers and Christmas Hampers and we also have Santa and his sleigh at a local supermarket. We recently began running a quiz night every six to eight weeks in the local social club which is now becoming well supported and is quite a fun night.

We also provide refreshments at the local Blue Cross Centre at their yearly dog show, summer fete and Christmas fete. We supply tea, coffee, cold drinks, rolls and cakes. All profits are Bromsgrove Lions Club but we donate an amount to Blue Cross at each event.

Each year we take the local Life After Stroke Club on a barge trip on the canal and we also give them a buffet lunch.

We have contributed to a piece of computer equipment to allow a young teenager with a form of motor neurone disease to speak via his computer.

We fund a swimming gala for the disabled at our local swimming baths but this is currently on hold as the organiser's wife is very ill. We hope to continue this in the future.

We also help local scouts and guides and have helped fund football strips and footballs for children's football clubs.

Attracting new members is extremely difficult and the club is now concerned that we may have to give up certain events as all members are well past retirement age and have ailments associated with old age and our two youngest members (both in their 60s) are stroke survivors. We need to give some serious thought during this year as how to proceed in the future.
