However donation to this particular project has been obfuscated by restrictions put in place by the Indian Government as regards donations of monies to Indian projects from outside of India. There are a series of forms and legal process that needs to be undertaken in order for the Charity to action this donation. This process continues at the present time.

The above conspired to confounded the Charities ability to actively engage in its Charitable donation purpose since its registration in January 2021.
