The Deanery made a generous donation of £9,865. Together with contributions from other donors, the charity raised a total of £10,465 during the reporting period.

During the same period, the charity supported two charitable organisations whose work aligns with our environmental and community-focused aims.

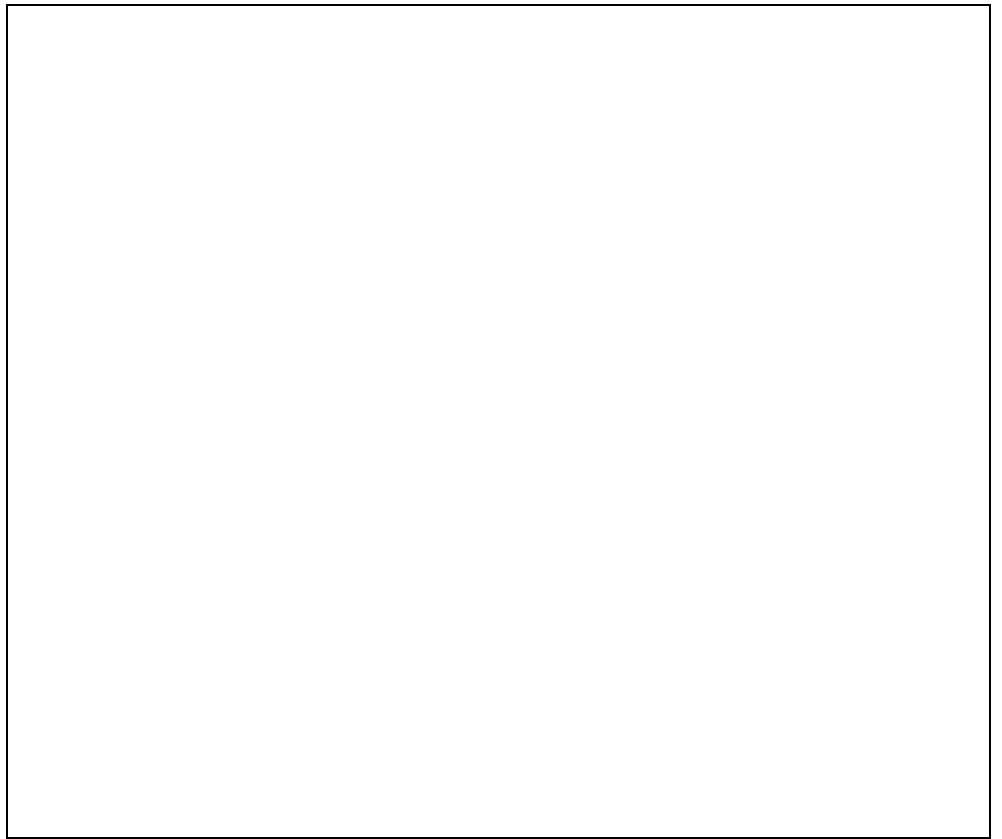

Swayyam, India

The charity also supported Black Hills CIC, based in the Gower Peninsula near Swansea, with a donation of £2,600.
