They also continued to work with the Borough to advance the Education, Health and Care provision for people living with Down Syndrome - The Trustees worked to develop a strategy for establishing Communication Groups and identifying potential candidates to deliver the groups.

It also used raised money to fund activities and resources in line with its objectives. An amount of £10400 that was donated to the charity for the specific purpose of running social communication groups for young people with Down Syndrome in the Borough remains in the charity bank account. The project is still in the process of being established. The charity completed the year with cash in the bank to the value of £26393.64, which will allow the charity to move forwards with meeting its objectives over the next year.

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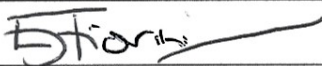

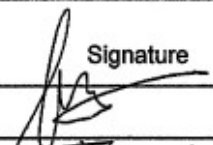
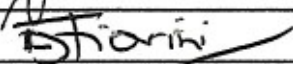
