The foundation as at now do not have any permanent/part-time paid staff or trustee. We are all purely volunteers.

The statement of financial activities shows a gross income of £20252.33 and total expenditure of £21014.35 leaving us with £1093.75 as balance for the year. The funding from The National Community Funding came in when we had closed business for the year so the project the funding was meant for will be executed in the coming year.
