The charity provides support to families in need who face medical expenses not covered by the state, as well as to larger families experiencing difficulty in meeting basic food requirements. Particular attention is given during Jewish holidays, such as the period preceding Passover, when the charity distributes both financial assistance and food to help alleviate hardship and ensure families can observe the celebrations with dignity.
