3. The advancement of education for the benefit of the public through the provision of courses and support for those engaged in the teaching or conducting of Gospel music.

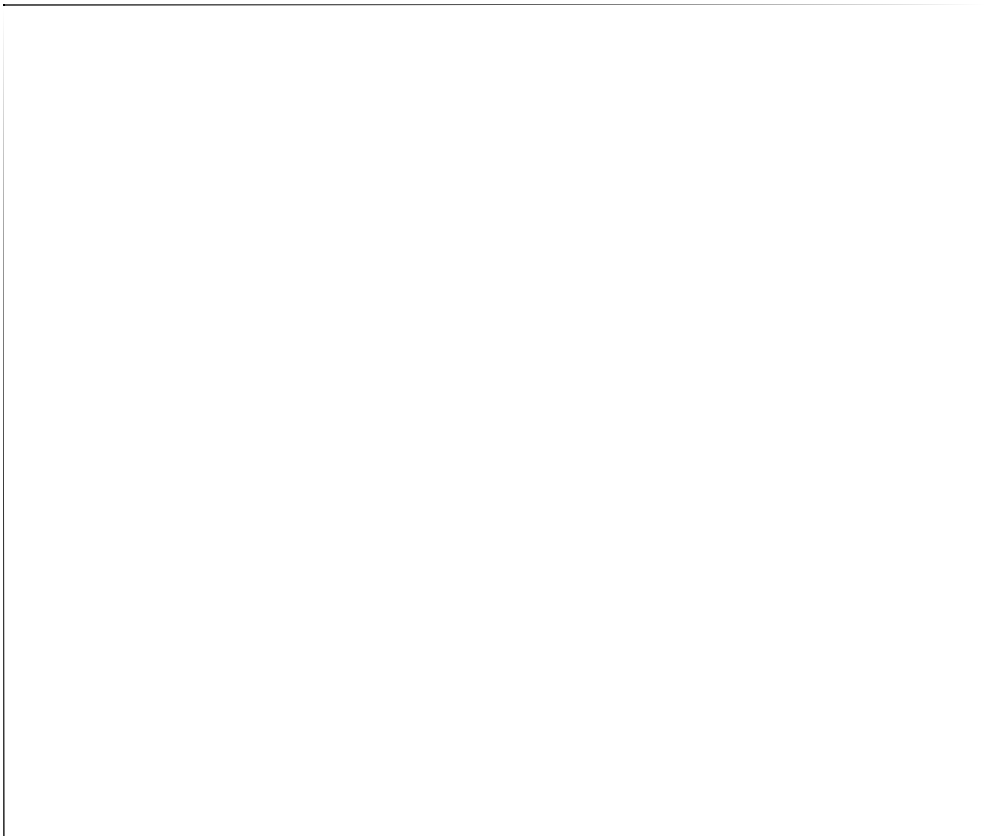
