Qalb Connection aim to alleviate poverty and suffering in third world countries. Qalb Connection raise funds through social media platforms, some advertising but mostly from word of mouth through family and friends.

Our objectives are to invest in clean drinking water projects, housing restoration projects and to provide food packages to alleviate poverty in the short term. Qalb Connection also invest in individuals to support them to self-sufficiency this has been in the past by providing sewing machines, farm animals such as chicken, buffalo and other cattle.
