Structure, Governance and Finance

The trustees, who served during the period from incorporation on 17 February 2021 were Daniel Green, Ronald Gorney, Deborah Meyer, Kerrin Rosenberg, and Michelle Sint. None of the trustees has any beneficial interest in the company.

The management of the charity is the responsibility of the trustees who are elected and co-opted under the terms of the Articles of Association. The number of trustees shall not be subject to any maximum but shall not be less than two. The appointment and training of a new trustee is subject to the oversight of current trustees.

There are no specific restrictions imposed by the governing document concerning the way the Charity can operate.

Charity's Objectives and Activities

The Charity's objective is the promotion of the Jewish faith by supporting and maintaining a place of worship and providing programmes of religious education, spiritual and pastoral welfare for the Jewish community.

Achievements and Performance

For the period under review the charity was financially inactive as the trustees investigated the contractual and legal agreements needed to take over the assets and liabilities of Ner Yisroel Educational Trust. These investigations are ongoing.

Public Benefit

The trustees acknowledge the duty in Section 4 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the Charity Commission's published general and relevant sub-sector guidance on public benefit.

All activities undertaken in the future by the charity will be for the public benefit.

Plans for the Future

When the assets and liabilities of the Ner Yisroel Educational Trust are passed over to the Charity, the Trustees will plan a range of programmes, and activities to support its objectives.

Reserves

There are no reserves for the period under review.

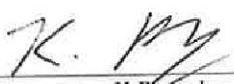
