1. Advancement of Education

(a) "To advance the education of young girls and women at Lumi International School by providing and assisting in the provision of formal education at a free secondary school.

(b) "For the public benefit to promote the education (including social and physical training) of women under the age of 30 years in Neno, Malawi in such ways as the charity trustees think fit, including by:
(1) Providing their education (including the study of music or other arts), to undertake travel in furtherance of that education or to prepare for entry to any occupation, trade or profession on leaving any educational establishment."

2. Advancement of Transportation

(a) "To provide transport facilities in Neno, Malawi for people who have special need of such facilities because they are living in isolated areas where there are no adequate public transport facilities by:

(1) operating a regular bus service using adapted vehicles between areas not otherwise served by public transport in order to allow accessibility to attend Lumi International School".

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Financial review

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	At the start of the financial year, the charity had in the bank account the amount of bank account £2,106.95 and we have £105.33 in cash held by trustee Teele Dunkley. The charity owed trustee Michaela Pavlovicova the sum of £2072.33 that she had spent on the running of charity events, marketing materials and running costs from her personal account, while we didn't have access to bank account and card payments to all trustees. This amount was returned to her and the remaining amount left on the account to cover the bank accounts monthly payments. Teele Dunkley currently still has 105.33 in cash for the charity.

All the rest of the money that are has not been used to the activities was held in our bank account and small amounts as petty cash by our trustees.
