ADVANCING IN LIFE AND HELPING YOUNG PEOPLE BY DEVELOPING THEIR SKILLS, CAPACITIES AND CAPABILITIES TO ENABLE THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN SOCIETY AS INDEPENDENT, MATURE AND RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS;B. PROVIDING RECREATIONAL AND LEISURE TIME ACTIVITY IN THE INTERESTS OF SOCIAL WELFARE FOR PEOPLE LIVING IN THE AREA OF BENEFIT WHO HAVE NEED BY REASON OF THEIR YOUTH, AGE, INFIRMITY OR DISABILITY, POVERTY OR SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CIRCUMSTANCES WITH A VIEW TO IMPROVING THE CONDITIONS OF LIFE OF SUCH PERSONS. 2. PROMOTING A SHARED CONVERSATION AND RESPONSE TO YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH & BULLYING IN WHICH EVERYONE WORKS TOGETHER RESPONSIBLY AND COLLABORATIVELY TO CREATE SAFE ENVIRONMENTS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.B. INSPIRING COMMUNITIES TO GET INVOLVED WITH SOCIAL CHANGE IN PROMOTING KINDNESS, ACCEPTANCE, AND INCLUSION.C. PROVIDING INFORMATIVE GUIDES FOR PARENTS TO UNDERSTAND THE DYNAMICS OF BULLYING, HELP THEIR CHILDREN THROUGH BULLYING SITUATIONS, AND LEARN HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH SCHOOL STAFF.D. EDUCATING STUDENTS WITH AGE-APPROPRIATE PROFESSIONAL RESOURCES AND INFORMATION TO MANAGE MENTAL HEALTH AND HOW TO BE SUPPORTIVE OF THEIR PEERS.E.
