The foodbank continues to provide free food to those who are most in need on the isle or Portland, We remain in partnership with Citizen Advice Bureau, where they provide an advisor who uses an office space provided by Portland Parish – and holds a drop in during the Tuesday sessions of the Foodbank. This adds greatly to the help we can provide.

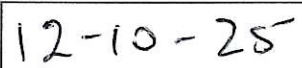

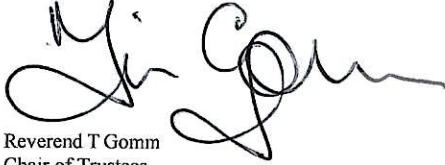

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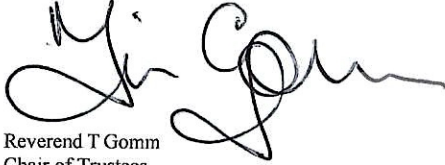
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
