Report of the Trustees
For the year ended 31 December 2023**

The Trustees have pleasure in presenting their report and the financial statements for the charity for the year ended 31 December 2023. The Trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The main objective and purpose for the charity is the prevention and relief of poverty in the rural areas of Malawi. The charity provides financial assistance to other local charities so that items and services to individuals in need, can be provided.

Objectives and aims

The trustees regularly refer to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit prior to decision making on approving financial assistance. A policy is in place to achieve our objectives. Financial assistance is made by invitation only to charities and organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty in Malawi. The trustees have considered the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit, including the guidance 'public benefit: running a charity (PB2)'.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Particularly the elderly, orphans and vulnerable children who are socially and economically at a greater disadvantage living in marginalised communities in rural areas of Malawi, have benefitted greatly and experienced relief from poverty due to the projects carried out via our financial assistance and grants. The local charities aim to reach out further and include a widow sponsorship program together with shelter facilities, amongst some more, very exciting projects to be announced in the near future.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The charity raised £42,469.44 from donations which were deposited by the general public, directly into the bank account. No monies were spent to generate this income. £6,460.09 was received from Gift Aid relief. The charity had a total of £48,929.53 plus £26,047.13 from the previous year, to spend in this financial year, however the charity only spent £50,556.62, leaving a cumulative balance of £24,420.04 in the bank to spend in the following financial year.

Reserves

The charity does not have a reserves policy because there are no expenses to cover in the UK. Grants and financial assistance are only available when funds are available in the bank.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is based on a Constitution - Foundation Model. The charity is constituted by Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO).

Apart from the first charity trustees, every trustee must be appointed for a term of three years by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the charity trustees. In selecting individuals for appointment as a charity trustee, the applicant must have skill, knowledge and experience for the effective administration of the CIO.

Pay policy for senior staff

Trustees are not paid directly or indirectly by the charity - It is all voluntary work.

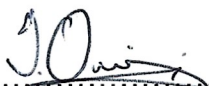

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, except for investments which are included at market value and the revaluation of certain fixed assets and in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102), and the Charities Act 2011.

The Heartwarmers Foundation meets the definition of a public benefit entity under FRS 102. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy note(s).
