Evangelism program in Democratic Republic of Congo in December 2021. The Gospel of Jesus Christ was preached.

We received donation of £9,300. This enabled us to have our crusades in the UK as well as outside the UK. Expenses amounted to £9,300 allowing us to stay just about afloat.
