2024 Review and Outlook for 2025:

Matthew Haddock was appointed as Musical Director in January 2024.

The charity's principal source of funds continues to be member subscription fees. In 2024 there was an increase in funding through ticket sales for public performances. We also received our first Gift Aid payment on membership subscriptions and will continue to raise claims in future. Therefore no increase in membership fees is considered necessary by the Trustees at present.

We were fortunate to receive a grant from Kelmarsh Windfarm Community Benefit in 2024. This will be spent on advertisements in local publications to attract new members (which will strengthen the band and increase resilience), personalised polo shirts, posters, banners, a sandwich board, and banners for music stands.

Expenditure on essentials has supported the key objectives of the charity, enabling development of musical skills of members, and performing for the local community at various events throughout the year.

Following a productive summer of paid performances and a review of the financial position of the band, the Trustees wrote a Mission Statement in collaboration with band members. In line with this, our 2025 aim will be to focus on an increase in free of charge performances in the local area for good causes.

A new Musical Director is due to be appointed in January 2024.

An increase is being considered, which will be reviewed in January 2024. Consideration will be given to other potential income sources, for example concert ticket sales and claiming Gift Aid on membership subscriptions. Expenditure has supported the key objectives of the charity, enabling development of musical skills of members, and performing for the local community at various events throughout the year.

NVB will continue to rehearse weekly during term time and we hope to continue to find new performance opportunities and recruit new members.



Review of 2022 and Outlook for 2023:

NVB will continue to rehearse weekly (during term time) and to arrange performance opportunities - for example Welford Christmas Tree Farm, Naseby Church and the Royal Oak Public House, plus any other additional concerts.

The band will continue to drive recruitment, building on work done in 2022 including advertising on Facebook, distributing flyers in the local area, advertising on WhatsApp and in the Welford village newsletter.

An increase in member subscription fees was considered in 2022 however Trustees agreed it was not necessary at this time due to grants received by Naseby Village Hall from the council which helped to reduce electricity costs. This will be reviewed in 2023.

Purpose of Naseby Village Band

Stated objectives: For the public benefit to advance, improve, develop and maintain public appreciation of the arts and science of music in such ways as the trustees think fit, including the practise and performance of concerts and other musical events, rehearsals and the training of individuals of all ages in music skills.

Action: Regular weekly meetings/practise sessions will be undertaken subject to Coronavirus limitations and concerts performed at the Naseby Church, Christmas Tree Farm and The Royal Oak Public House to celebrate Christmas, Easter and other events. Regular social media posts will be undertaken to attract new members and a broader spread of musical instruments. The charity will in due course seek to attract donations from attendees at the venues to supplement the cost of sheet music and supporting equipment such as music stands. HMRC will be approached to register the Charity for Gift Aid.

The year to 31st December 2021 has been significantly impacted by the advent of Coronavirus and the limitations it has imposed on social distances and public gatherings. Band practise and performance has been curtailed by reason of these issues.

The Naseby Village Bank has been funded by reason of the subscriptions of the members only.
