This required the design of the programme to ensure it meets UK higher education benchmarks in conjunction with ability to provide a resilience curriculum with the potential to be delivered across a wider range of physical environments.</p> <p>The degree was validated by a UK university in March 2022.</p> <p>The charity started funding raising for the delivery of the programmes in March 2022.</p> <p>Then charity then moved onto planning the September 2022 launch of the degree programme in South Sudan. This involved the development of the learning material, student recruitment and logistical planning.</p>


