The Church conducted its range of ministry through 2021-2022 from its site at Woodend, with a mixture of online and in person activities as appropriate. It is a very new ministry and looking forward to seeing growth. Eric Reid has assumed overall leadership. Shabach Praise Ministries (SPM) is committed to developing the role of this Christian Ministry in the local community and to enabling as many people as possible to worship at our church, become part of our parish community and a positive influence on all those we encounter on a day to day basis.
