This charity was registered on 30th July, 2021 with charity number 1195355.

Our Mission

We are driven by passion to help reduce poverty, educate needy children and contribute to fulfilling the Sustainable Development Goals 1, 2, 3, 4, and 10.

Our Vision

Our vision is to substantially affect the quality of life and wellbeing of children and families that are below the poverty line.

Our Objective
