Achievements & Performance

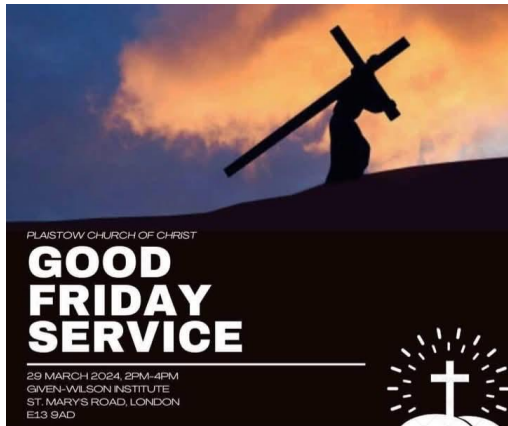

Through this program, we strengthened our connection with the local community, reflecting Christ's love in action during the Christmas season.

Aim and Purposes
