It's beneficiaries are mainly in Pakistan, and funding streams are through fundraising events.</p> <p>The rationale for our reserve policy, would be specifically for our Langhar Food Service and would mitigate any gaps in funding between future events.</p> <p>The reserve policy is in place to mitigate any unforeseen circumstances in the form of costs, as well as fluctuations in exchange rate in currency,</p> <p>The level of reserves is set at £500, as we deem this amount adequate enough should we have any shortfalls in funds.</p> <p>This policy will be reviewed yearly, and on an event by event basis.</p>


