Lle'Chi is governed by ESTYN. ESTYN is led by the Chief Inspector of Education and Training in Wales and inspects quality and standards in education. Lle'Chi has not received an inspection as of yet, but will be in the next year, and every four years after that.

The aim of the CIO is promoting Welsh-medium education for pre-school children in Blaenau Ffestiniog area.

Lle'Chi provides morning and afternoon education and flying start sessions throughout the week, and lunchtime childcare session, during term time for the public benefit. The Cylch follows the Curriculum for Wales Foundation phase and it provides this exclusively through the medium of Welsh. The Cylch Meithrin is accessible for all children between 2 and 4 years in the Blaenau Ffestiniog area and these children, and their families, therefore are the beneficiaries of this charity.


