**Achievements and Performance**

Continuation of services where we meet to worship, take communion and listen to teaching to grow and encourage people in their faith.

Time for Tea - a vintage tea run for the elderly in our community in the Community Centre. Home-made cakes free of charge but we took a donation which we donated to a different charity every month. This carried on in the community until July 2023 when we handed the event over to another local church to carry on.

Bereavement Support Group – we met in the Community Centre once a month where people who attended were able to meet others who were going through the same experience and where there was always a listening ear and support. This came to an end because we felt that we had supported people enough that they had made friends within the group and were able to meet outside of the group to support each other. If we see a need arise again, we will open up another support group. Jenny Collins has registered with local funeral directors as a celebrant and if she feels there is enough to begin another group, that will be facilitated again.

We have continued to develop our YouTube channel where we do online bible studies and teaching to encourage people in their faith.

Jenny Collins is writing a book which will be sold on Amazon etc. Any funds raised will go into the ministry to support the ongoing work.





