Notes on concerts

- Craig Greene was our first-ever 'Artist in Residence' in 2024.
- The concert at Aylesbury had low ticket sales despite the marketing power of ATG behind it. We made the decision never to return to this venue due to the financial losses incurred.
- We performed our first-ever Family concert to a delighted audience. We received grant funding from MKCF to support this event.
- The East-West concert was completely covered by the Middle Eastern Culture Group of Milton Keynes. In reality, they didn't have the following to fill the venue, but those who attended enjoyed the mixture of middle eastern music and western favourites.
- We held our first Conducting Weekend in November 2024. Eight Participants were selected and joined us for the weekend. They paid to participate with NC securing a grant to pay for part of the weekend. It was a great success with 3 chosen to conduct part of the evening concert on 10 Nov.

- The Christmas event just wasn't attract enough audiences. For 2025 we have collaborated with the Danesborough Chorus and moved to Woburn Church.
- March '25: "I am Woman" celebrated Women in the area with an all-female concert featuring choirs, orchestra, jazz, opera and dramatic performance. It attracted a sponsor who has already promised to sponsor the next event.
- 31 May '25 – first time without a conductor. Audiences commented 'Best concert we've ever done' Dominic Moore was spectacular and the cost of a smaller group of players took the pressure of finances away.

Outreach

2023

Band in a Van performs events at Family and Children's Centre, Adult Learning Locations, Libraries, AGE UK and centres for the visually impaired. Locations in Buckinghamshire and Milton Keynes.

Our expert team provide music, song and interaction workshops at Care Homes in Milton Keynes and Aylesbury.

2024

Band in a Van performs over 60 events at Family and Children's Centre, Adult Learning Locations, Libraries, AGE UK and centres for the visually impaired Plus S.E.N schools. More locations, now in Buckinghamshire, MK and Central Bedfordshire.

Our expert team provide music, song and interaction workshops at Care Homes in Milton Keynes, Aylesbury and Buckingham. These included 1-2-1's for those with limited mobility.

2025

Band in a Van performs over 60 events at Family and Children's Centre, Adult Learning Locations, Libraries, AGE UK and centres for the visually impaired. Again, locations expanding in Buckinghamshire, MK, Central Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire. Plus VE Day performances for the MKC Council and MK Rose.

Our expert team provide music, song and interaction workshops at Care Homes in Milton Keynes, Aylesbury and Buckingham. These included 1-2-1's for those with limited mobility.

Our GCSE live set work event is now a regular fixture at The Stables. In partnership with the MK Music Service, we perform excerpts of music from the syllabus, explain the music and history behind it to a packed audience of local music students.

'Artist in Residence' Craig Greene performed a Piano masterclass for students at The Royal Latin School in 2024.

A new initiative 'The New School Project' started in 2024. This was a small ensemble which travelled to schools with little music provision. It provided a short performance, but also explained a little music theory as part of the event. It performed at two schools in Milton Keynes: Oakgrove School and Hazeley Academy. More events are being planned for later in the year.

Engagements

Alina continues to be engaged by the Danesborough Chorus and MK Chorale for concerts. The Orchestra charges 15% administration fees for these, which is reasonable. Next event will take place on 28 June, in Woburn.

Our String Quartet is used by the University of Buckingham for all of their Graduation events. Again, we charge a 15% administration fee for all events. Next event 6 July, at Christ the Cornerstone in MK.

The Orchestra was engaged to perform to a selected audience at The Garrick Club, London in February 2025.

Other engagements have included: A string quartet for an MKCF function in Chicheley Hall, a performance with Leighton Buzzard Festival Singers in Leighton Buzzard and Carmina Burana with Newport Pagnell Festival Singers.

Awards

In 2024, Band in a Van was shortlisted for a 'Music Teacher of the Year' award by Classic FM'

In 2025, the Orchestra was shortlisted for an 'Inspiration Award' in Milton Keynes.

CD

The Orchestra featured on the Will Todd CD 'All Will be Well' which was recorded at Metropolis Studios in London and released by Signum Records. The record company covered all orchestral costs and has provided us with 50 sale or return copies of the CD. £5 cost and sale price £12.

Trustees' annual report on activities - 22/23 Season

Concerts:

The Orchestra's concert season featured two concerts at The Venue MK. 1 October 2022 saw Alina perform with soloist, Cristian Grajner de Sa in a concert that featured The Lark Ascending and Beethoven's first symphony and on 10 March 2023, we performed 'Concierto de Aranjuez' with guitarist, Hugh Millington. We performed twice at the Radcliffe Centre at The University of Buckingham, firstly a concert featuring our wind section 'Wind Serenade' on 25 February 2023, and similarly with our string section 'String Serenade' at the same venue on 17 June 2023.

To mark the coronation of King Charles III, we created a concert 'Celebrate! Music for the Coronation' which took place at the church of St Peter and St Paul in Newport Pagnell at the request of former mayor of MK, Amanda Marlow on 5 May 2023. The Orchestra was joined by Polymnia Choir and soloist, Jessica Wise to perform traditional a concert of coronation anthems. Finally, we repeated our Christmas concert at St Edwards Church in Milton Keynes on 17 December 2022, which featured the Orchestra's brass section and the local church choir.

Outreach

The Orchestra's Band in a Van group took its family-friendly, unique, interactive style of events to Family Centres, Libraries and many more locations in Milton Keynes and Buckinghamshire. These included: Saplings Children's Centre, Chesham Library, Chiltern Stroke Association, 'Bands on the Green' and even the Buckinghamshire Library Conference in Aylesbury to name just a few.

Our expert team of workshop leaders took music, communication and song to Care Homes in the region. We worked closely with residents at Flowers House, Milton Court in Milton Keynes and two homes under the Fremantle group in Bucks across the season offering a committed programme of workshops designed to support those with dementia.

We performed a side-by-side concert with Milton Keynes Music Hub on 15 July 2023 with professional musicians sitting within a number of the Hub's student groups. This was an incredible 'one-off' experience for all involved. We also worked with the MK Music Hub on 21 Feb 2023 to create a live GCSE set-work concert for music students in the area. The event featured extracts of works on the GCSE Music syllabus performed live, broken down into the most relevant moments with questions and interaction constant between the audience and stage.

The Orchestra team held a 'Come and Sing' on 11 March 2023 at the Radcliffe Centre, Buckingham. The theme was 'What's Love Got To Do with It?' leading to learning and performing of songs by Tina Turner, Queen, Nat King Cole and many more. It was a great day of amateur music-making supported by a small group of professional musicians from the Orchestra.

ASOS JUL 20

We created two new community projects in this season, which were specially developed in order to support and promote the local community -

Warriors highlighted Women in Milton Keynes during the Women's Euro 2022 football tournament. We collaborated with MOTUS dance to develop a project for young dancers and musicians which also cut to a large video screen to show a series of specially nominated women from MK (Warriors). We performed twice to audiences in the fanzone in MK.

'I Am Woman' was the second new project and this time, used a specially created concert to highlight the incredible women of Milton Keynes and surrounds around the date of International Women's Day. This was a moment to celebrate women and also create a concert that showcased all of those talented females.

Engagements

The Orchestra continues to be engaged from the community to perform at events. In our 2022/23 season, we collaborated and performed with:

Baton of Hope, which highlighted suicide prevention as it 'travelled' around the country. We provided a String Quartet at the Milton Keynes leg of this incredible endeavour.

Danesborough Chorus - We performed with them twice, firstly on 18 March 2023 performing Dvorak's Stabat Mater and 24 June, featuring Puccini's Messa di Gloria. Both events taking place at St Mary's Church, Woburn under the baton of Ian Smith.

Stowe School engaged the Orchestra for a one-off concert that included Mozart's Requiem at the school chapel on 19 November 2022. Alina performed under the baton of Craig Greene.

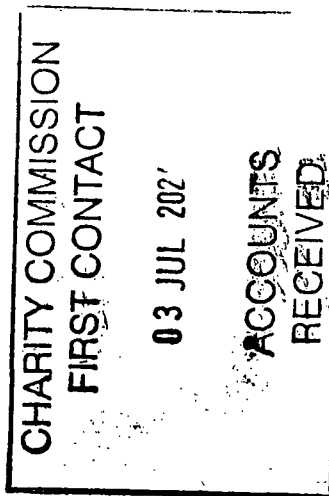

Trustees' annual report on activities - 21/22 Season

Concerts

Alina Orchestra's 2021/22 season featured three concerts at The Venue, MK. The 11 September 2021 concert featured Mozart's Symphony no.41, with 18 March 2022 featuring Piano Concerto no.17 , also by Mozart and finally 21 May 2022 which featured an all-Mozart programme.

The orchestra also performed an all string programme at The Radcliffe Centre, University of Buckingham, where it is ***Orchestra in Residence***, on 9 April 2022 featuring music by Finzi, Elgar, Respighi and Holst. As part of its core concert season, the orchestra brass section joined forces with the Christmas Choir of St Edwards to perform a Christmas Concert at St Edward the Confessor Catholic Church on 17 December 2021.

Outreach:

- Band in a Van's interactive, family-friendly, events took place in Wendover, Aylesbury, Great Missenden, High Wycombe, Micklefield and Amersham Libraries to delighted members of the local community.
The Band in a Van group also performed in concert format 'Brass Attack' at Aylesbury Waterside Theatre to mark the opening of the Norman Bragg Space.
- To mark the occasion of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, the orchestra held a 'Jubilee Come and Sing' where participants sang songs celebrating the decades of HRH Queen Elizabeth's reign and also performed them to an audience at the end of the day. This event was funded with a grant from The National Lottery Community Fund and was held at The Radcliffe Centre, University of Buckingham.

- The orchestra started its programme of music workshops in Care Homes in March 2022 with 10 weekly sessions at Lewin House and Fremantle Court Care Homes in Aylesbury.

Engagements:

The orchestra performed the following engagements during the period:

13 November 2021: Concert at Woburn Church, Beds with the Danesborough Chorus.

22 March 2022: The orchestra performed a GCSE 'set work' concert to Hertfordshire Students, funded by Hertfordshire Music Service.

2 June 2022: 'Music for a Royal Occasion' concert in Bicester Church. This event was sponsored by Bicester Village Shopping Centre.

5 June 2022: Jubilee Concert with MK Chorale at Milton Keynes Theatre.

2 July 2022: Concert at Woburn Church, Beds with the Danesborough Chorus.

3 August 2022: Drum Workshop, Campbell Park, Milton Keynes as part of its 'Playdays' day for children and families.

19 August 2022: MK Proms, Campbell Park, Milton Keynes.

As part of a reciprocal agreement with The University of Buckingham, the orchestra provided String musicians for graduation ceremonies on 25 October, 6 November, 26 January. The string players also performed at the Milton Keynes City Status Bid on 8 December 2021 at The Milton Keynes Gallery and at a Mother's Day function on 27 March at The Blossom Room in Milton Keynes.

The orchestra brass section performed at Novotel Hotel and Harben House, Milton Keynes on 28 December 2021 for migrant communities.
