Para 1.20	<p>There are over 150 children registered at Bethesda Centre. These children receive regular physiotherapy sessions and benefit from social contact, one to one play time and other activities.</p> <p>During this year all the children registered have received protein rich porridge flour to combat malnutrition and to help the children grow healthy.</p> <p>As need arises disabled children are helped with mobility aids such as wheelchairs and crutches, and verticalisers. In the past year this has also involved the provision of locally made boots, shoes and braces.</p> <p>Operation costs are paid for those with need and who live in extreme poverty. The focus is on life saving and life changing surgeries.</p> <p>Various trainings have taken place, raising awareness of disability amongst children in our community, as well as ongoing staff training on a weekly basis. First aid training and also grief workshops to help those who have lost children.</p> <p>Visits were made to children in their homes to help those in particular need and to encourage mothers in difficulty.</p> <p>Bethesda has had a functioning food bank to provide food aid for our most vulnerable families.</p> <p>Families have also been supported during times of grief and loss. Financial gifts have been given to help defer expenses.</p>

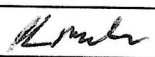
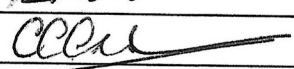
