Through these activities, the charity seeks to promote spiritual development and provide tangible support to individuals and families experiencing hardship, thereby delivering clear public benefit.



## **INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF MISSIONARIES OF APOSTOLIC GRACE**

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of Missionaries of Apostolic Grace (the "Charity") for the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

### **Responsibilities and basis of report**

As the charity trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 (the "Act").

I report in respect of my examination of the Charity's accounts carried out under section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 and in carrying out my examination, I have followed all the applicable Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the Act.
