Applicants must live, study or work in the Broadland, North Norfolk or Great Yarmouth Borough council districts, must be aged 21 or under and must demonstrate a need.

Structure and Details of How Managed

The Charity is managed directly by the Trustees who meet monthly either online, in person or a mixture of the two. An agenda and any relevant papers are circulated in advance and decisions recorded. One or more Trustees will then action the decision.

Activities and objectives in the year

During this period, the Charity focused upon raising its profile in the local area, including expansion to include Breckland, and in particular encouraging applications from young people who might qualify for help.

Achievements and performance (including reporting on public benefit)

During the period, the Charity received 27 applications of which 16 were accepted and a further five applicants failed to respond to requests for further information. Generally, each application was for an individual but one of the 27 applications was for three young people and another was for two. Of the six that were declined, one

was over the age limit, one was from out of our area and a further four failed to meet other criteria.

The 16 accepted applications supported young people in their education or work environment where their families could not afford to do so by:

- Providing Chromebooks, laptops or stationery, etc for use in school, college or at university;
- Funding gym membership or providing sports kit for young people to exercise and build their confidence;
- Funding resources for young people using the YMCA;
- Funding a bus pass for travel to and from school.

In addition, the Charity again supported the Coats4Kids initiative by funding coats for 321 students at a cost of £8,025.

Financial review

Although the Charity was not actively seeking donations during this period, we received further donations of £4,000 as well as Gift Aid of £1,000, received £219 from fund-raising activities and bank interest of £383. The Charity gave out a total of £9,560 and incurred £120 in professional fees plus £27 for bank charges.



Activities and objectives in the year

During this period, the Charity focused upon raising its profile in the local area, including expansion in Great Yarmouth, and in particular encouraging applications from young people who might qualify for help.

Achievements and performance (including reporting on public benefit)

During the period, the Charity received 18 applications of which eight were accepted and a further four applicants failed to respond to requests for further information. Of the six that were declined, two were over the age limit and a further four failed to meet other criteria.

The nine accepted applications supported young people in education where their families could not afford to do so:

- Travel costs to and from school for three students
- Gym membership and equipment for two students
- Holt Youth Project Achieving Confidence Training for two attendees
- Clothing
- Help with holiday

In addition, the Charity supported the Coats4Kids initiative by funding coats for 323 students at a cost of £8,085.

Financial review

Although the Charity was not actively seeking donations during this period, we received further donations of £4,500 as well as Gift Aid of £1,000 and bank interest of £59. The Charity gave out a total of £11,068 and incurred £102 of bank charges.

The Independent Trustee was approached and appointed following a discussion and agreement about the Charity's need. She was suggested by one of the Trustees who already knew the individual concerned and their qualifications for the role.

Activities and objectives in the year

During this period, the Charity focused upon raising its profile in the local area and in particular encouraging applications from young people who might qualify for help.

Achievements and performance (including reporting on public benefit)

During the period, the Charity received 20 applications of which nine were accepted and a further four applicants failed to respond to requests for further information. Of

the seven that were declined, five were from young people out of the area and one who was over the age limit.

The nine accepted applications supported young people in education where their families could not afford to do so:

- Four Chromebooks were provided to school students;
- Replacement PE kit for a school student;
- Repairs to a damaged bicycle to enable the student to continue to attend school;
- A laptop and specialist software was provided to enable a student to study a course at college;
- The Charity, in conjunction with the Rotary Club of Aylsham, part funded a geography field trip for a school student;
- A replacement mobile phone for a young person to carry on their work and voluntary activities.

Financial review

Although the Charity was not actively seeking donations during this period, we received further donations of £4,320 as well as Gift Aid of £2,261. The Charity gave out a total of £1,374 and incurred £41 of bank charges.

The Independent Trustee was approached and appointed following a discussion and agreement about the Charity's need. She was suggested by one of the Trustees who already knew the individual concerned and their qualifications for the role.

Activities and objectives in the year

In February 2022, the Trustees agreed to invite Lady Dannatt, the Lord Lieutenant for Norfolk, to become the Charity's Patron as she had known

Jim Agnew for many years and we were delighted when she accepted.

The Charity was formally launched in Aylsham Town Hall on the evening of Thursday, 26 May 2022. Some 35 people attended the launch, including representatives of the Norfolk Magistrates, the Norfolk County Council Youth Offending Team, the Benjamin Foundation, as well as the Agnew family and Rotary. They heard our Patron, Lady Dannatt, relate how she had known Jim since they were children and that his compassion and experience as Chair of the Youth Bench would last with the work of the new Charity. The Chair of Trustees, Rotarian Geoff Sadler, then explained why the Charity was needed in this area, what it would do and how to apply. Following these presentations, much interest was shown through a lively question and answer session.

Prior to the launch event, the Charity's own website was set up at www.jimagnewcharity.org.

Other publicity activities were carried out to raise the profile of the Charity among potential applicants and particularly through contact with other charities and organisation that work with young people. However, no applications for assistance had been received by 31 August 2022, the end of this reporting period.

Achievements and performance (including reporting on public benefit)

In this first year, most activity focused on setting up the Charity and, without any request for assistance during this period, it did not provide any assistance to young people. However, the foundations have been created for the provision of support to young people in the future.

Financial review

Given the initial focus explained above, the Charity received income but it had no expenditure.




