OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

FINANCIAL REVIEW

During the period to 31st May 2025 income of £18,000 (2024 - £28,667) was received by the charity. There was £59,621 in the account on 31/5/2025.


TRUSTEES RESPONSIBILITIES IN RELATION TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
