Organised half a day conference in Birmingham on 18th February 2025 for health professionals who were interested in the rebuilding of the health system in Yemen.

One of our trustees visited Yemen in April 2025 and produced a [report](#)¹ on public health in rural areas in some parts of Taiz Governorate. This report was shared with our partners [Peoples Praxis https](#), and the [Yemen SIG](#), Faculty of Public Health. At the time of writing this report, we are working on online and in person refresher courses for those rural health workers in the area.

Organised three online workshops between 2021 and 2023 for the Yemeni and Arab community in Britain on diet, illness, and the fasting during the month of Ramadan. We also organised another online workshop on cancer.

In partnership with [Peoples Praxis https](https://www.peoplespraxis.org/), and the [Yemen SIG](https://www.yemen-sig.org/), Faculty of Public Health, we are developing an online mentoring programme called Yemen Public Health Praxis. This is offered for Yemeni candidates who have done their public health studies and seeking further advice on developing their couriers. This online mentoring programme is for anyone from the Low Middle Income Countries (LMIC). It's an ongoing project.

We conducted an online dental public health review in Yemen and we're in the process of finalising this project.

Two of our trustees produced two short reports. One was on the deteriorating health in Maqbana, Taiz, Yemen. The other one was a snapshot of the health situation in the divided city of Taiz as a result of the war.




