To promote the relief of sickness and the preservation of health among people living in Yemen and in the UK. For Yemenis in Yemen people suffer from mental or physical illness as a result of war in Yemen or in need of rehabilitation as a result of such illness.

Organised half a day conference in Birmingham on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2025 for health professionals who were interested in the rebuilding of the health system in Yemen.

One of our trustees visited Yemen in April 2025 and produced a [report](#)<sup>1</sup> on public health in rural areas in some parts of Taiz Governorate. This report was shared with our partners [Peoples Praxis https](#), and the [Yemen SIG](#), Faculty of Public Health. At the time of writing this report, we are working on online and in person refresher courses for those rural health workers in the area.




