The organisation is a charitable incorporated organisation registered with the Charity Commission number 1196407. MET:Revive carries out its activities under the operating name of Methodist Evangelicals Together.

Mrs Elizabeth Miller - Trustee

Rev Nicola Briggs – Trustee (appointed 26 May 2025)

Mrs Roz Addington – Trustee (appointed 26 May 2025)

Rev Dr David Hull - Chair and Trustee (until 16 November 2024)

During the year the meeting of Trustees agreed that the Trustees and Executive meetings should now be combined in order to save duplication at meetings. This method of meeting has now been implemented for the 2025/26 year and the Trustees now meet with other officers in attendance. During the year we have met to set the strategy and policy of the organisation. In addition there have been several ad hoc conversations that have taken place. All the Trustees are volunteers. Meetings during 2024/2025 were the Executive Meeting (twice), Trustees (once), with the AGM taking place in May.

Trustees are appointed by AGM. Trustees are appointed for a term of three years beginning 1 January and eligible for re-election once, and beyond that only by special resolution of the AGM. Elections are held at the AGM preceding re-election. An AGM was held on 26 May 2025.

The principal office of the charity is MET Revive, PO Box 184, WELLINGTON, TA21 1DQ

The role of Chair changed in November 2024 with David Hull handing over to Chris Briggs.

Methodist Evangelicals Together (MET) stands for the following core purposes and objectives:

- Upholding the Authority of the Bible
- Seeking Spiritual Renewal
- Praying for Revival
- Spreading Scriptural Holiness
- Emphasising the Centrality of the Cross
- Encouraging Evangelism through Relationship, Prayer, Word and Action

MET employs a part time Administrator, Mrs Marian Izzard. During a sabbatical, administrative support was provided on a paid basis from Mr John Hogarth. Rev Dr David Hull provides connection and contact at grass roots as our MET:Revive Ambassador.

The charity produces a magazine, RE:VIVE (formerly known as MET Connexion), three times a year. Mrs Izzard is also the Editor of the magazine, a paid role separate from her administrative duties. MET:Revive organises annual conferences including: The REVIVE Gathering (a weekend focussing on worship, prayer and renewal) and Equipping for Ministry Conferences (more latterly carried out through Zooms Webinars). Various books and Bible study guides are produced for sale.

The website is kept up-to-date at metrevive.uk, and we have a Facebook group for members only and a Facebook page for public information.

The public benefit is the advancement of the Christian religion in accordance with clause 4 of our constitution.

Funding

The charity is funded by its members who pay an annual subscription and through additional gifts from its members and supporters.

Financial Outcome

For the year ended 31 August 2025 there is net cash surplus of £24,241 (year ended to 31 August 2024: £5,768). At the year end the balance in unrestricted funds was £87,673 with a further £36,709 held within restricted funds.

The reserves policy is reassessed annually by the trustees and is to retain sufficient balance within unrestricted funds to close the charity, currently estimated to be £10,000. As at 31 August 2025, surplus reserves are held for future years to fund the Ambassador post in the absence of grant income.

It is currently policy to retain at least £2,000 within the Donald English Young Scholars Fund and to reduce the balance to that level over the next few years. During the year a donation of £15,000 was added to this fund. The availability of this fund and the remit of it will be drawn to the attention of the MET constituency.

Rising Generation fund - the trustees will explore how this could be used to support young people in the growth of their faith.

Director of Ministry fund – Most of this fund has been transferred as permitted by the donors to the Ambassador Role. The Administrator had contacted the donors in relation to this.

Marriage & Human Relationships fund – it is envisaged that monies held in this fund will be used in resourcing the work of MET:Revive in the year ahead as well as seeking opportunities to resource teaching for young people.

Funding

The charity is funded by its members who pay an annual subscription and through additional gifts from its members and supporters.

Legal and Administrative information

The organisation is a charitable incorporated organisation registered with the Charity Commission number 1196407.

During the period the principal Trustees and officers were:

Rev Dr David Hull - Chairman and Trustee

Miss Lynn Petersen - Trustee (resigned 31 December 2022)

Rev Gareth Higgs – Trustee

Mrs Elizabeth Miller - Trustee (appointed 1 January 2023)

The Executive Committee (which includes the Trustees) has met once during the period, in May 2022, to set the policy of the organisation, with several ad hoc conversations also taking place. All the Trustees are volunteers.

Trustees are proposed from the Executive and nominees are presented to the AGM, with a reasoned statement, for approval. Trustees are appointed for a term of three years beginning 1 January and eligible for re-election once, and beyond that only by special resolution of the AGM. Elections are held at the AGM preceding re-election. An AGM was held on 4 June 2022.

The charity Methodist Evangelicals Together, charity number 298087, had formed the company Methodist Evangelicals Together Limited, a company limited by guarantee (Company Number 08837912, England & Wales), which was dormant since its incorporation. At the AGM of the charity number 298087, held on 12 June 2021, the decision had been taken to move from the registered charity to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation, as it was felt that this would best safeguard the future interests of the charity, and for the company limited by guarantee to be dissolved once this had taken place. The transfer was achieved on 1 January 2022, with assets, and trade, activities and staff of the charity being successfully transferred to the newly formed Methodist Evangelicals Together CIO, charity number 1196407. Steps were taken to dissolve the company limited by guarantee, Methodist Evangelicals Together Limited, and this dissolution was completed on 5 April 2022.

The principal office of the charity is 50a Castle Road, Newport, Isle of Wight, PO30 1DP.

Objectives, Activities & Achievements

Methodist Evangelicals Together (MET) stands for the following core purposes and objectives:

- Upholding the Authority of the Bible
- Seeking Spiritual Renewal
- Praying for Revival
- Spreading Scriptural Holiness
- Emphasising the Centrality of the Cross
- Encouraging Evangelism through Relationship, Prayer, Word and Action

Following the transfer and until 31 August 2022, the Development Worker, Rev Derek Balsdon, was employed on a full time basis to promote the work of MET. During this period he was the main speaker at REVIVE, our annual residential prayer weekend, and hosted twice weekly prayer meetings and Bible studies on Zoom. He also had a role in pastoral care for evangelicals within the British Methodist Church.

MET employs a part time Administrator, Mrs Marian Izzard.

The charity produces a magazine, MET Connexion, three times a year. Mrs Izzard is also the Editor of the magazine, a paid role separate from her administrative duties. MET organises three annual conferences: REVIVE (a Prayer Weekend), Digging for Treasure (a day's teaching on expository preaching) and Equipping for Ministry (a weekend for probationary ministers and ministers with fewer than 5 years' experience). Unfortunately, the Equipping for Ministry weekend did not go ahead this spring. Various books and Bible study guides are produced for sale.

The website is kept up-to-date at www.methodistevangelicals.org.uk, and we have two Facebook pages, one for members only and the other for public information.

The public benefit is the advancement of the Christian religion in accordance with clause 4 of our constitution.

Funding

The charity is funded by its members who pay an annual subscription and through additional gifts from its members and supporters.

Financial Outcome

On 1 January 2022, balances in unrestricted funds of £48,104 and £23,770 within restricted funds were transferred from Methodist Evangelicals Together (registration number 298087). For the period ended 31 August 2022 there is net cash surplus of £3,183.
