THIS HAS BENEFITTED OVER 220 LOCAL MUSLIMS ATTENDING FOR DAILY PRAYER AND ISLAMIC EDUCATION HELD ON WEEKDAYS AND HAS BENEFITTED MANY MORE LOCAL PEOPLE. THE TRUSTEES HAVE HAD DUE REGARD TO THE GUIDANCE ISSUED BY THE CHARITY COMMISSION ON PUBLIC BENEFIT AND ARE SATISFIED THAT THEY ARE ADVANCING ISLAM FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT.

DURING THE YEAR, THE CHARITY SECURED £54,207 INCOME, WHICH WERE MAINLY DONATIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND. THE CHARITY HAD EXPENDITURE OF £28,058 WHICH WAS MAINLY FOR PROPERTY AND UTILITY COSTS. THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS WHICH WAS RETAINED MAINLY FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS. THE RESERVES OF THE CHARITY WERE £32,592 AT YEAR END. THE POLICY OF THE TRUSTEES IS NOT TO HOLD ANY RESERVES BUT TO USE ANY SURPLUS OR RESERVES FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE.
