4. Financial Review

Income

The total income for the year amounted to **£1,227**. This income was primarily raised through donations and small fundraising activities.

Expenditure

Total expenditure during the year was **£337**, with funds spent on community outreach, supplies, and running costs.

Reserves Policy

The charity maintains a modest level of reserves to ensure it can meet its obligations and continue essential services. The trustees aim to build a more sustainable reserve in future periods.

Financial Position

At year-end, the charity held a surplus of £890, which will be carried forward to the next financial year and allocated to future planned projects.

- Launch new initiatives focused on empowerment and wellbeing.
