The director presents his report and accounts for the year ended 31 January 2025.

Principal activities

The company is a registered charity under registration number 1196536. Its principal activity during the year continued to be prevention or relief of poverty [or financial hardship] anywhere in the world by providing: grants, items and services to individuals in need and/or charities, or other organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty; the relief and assistance of people in any part of the world who are the victims of war or natural disaster, trouble, or catastrophe in particular by the supply of medical aid to such persons; the relief of those in need, by reason of youth, age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage, by providing grants, items and/or services to individuals and/or charities and to advance such other charitable purposes that are charitable under the laws of England and Wales as the trustees see fit, from time to time, anywhere in the world.

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

The Charity is governed by trustees drawn from the local community. This is to ensure that it has the skills and experience required to oversee the management of the charity and its operations.

Trustee Induction and Training

All new trustees receive a planned induction programme before taking up their place on the board. This includes an explanation of their roles and responsibilities, an introduction to other trustees, an overview of recent business and an explanation of board format and process.

Reserves policy

The trustee aims to ensure that sufficient funds are maintained to enable the company to carry out its activities.

Risk management

The trustees have examined the major strategic, business and operational risks which the company faces and confirm that systems have been established to enable regular reports to be produced so that the necessary steps can be taken to lessen these risks.

Public Benefit Statement

The trustees have considered the general guidance on public benefit issued by the Charities Commission and have taken due regard of that guidance. The trustees consider that they are satisfied that the charity's activities do provide a public benefit.

Results for the year

The charity achieved a surplus of £6,489 (2023: £405) for the year.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustee of Sayaban Welfare Trust
