The purpose of the Euphonium Foundation is to promote improve, develop and maintain public education in and appreciation of the art and science of music and specifically in the art of playing the euphonium by the presentation of concerts, recitals, competitions, meetings, lectures, seminars, training courses and by the commissioning of new works of high quality for the euphonium and any other related activities.

The charity is controlled by its governing document, the constitution of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation whose only voting members are its charity trustees.

The trustees confirm that they have complied with the requirements of section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

The income for the year totalled £5,074.44 (2024 - £26,434.60) with costs of £16,600 (2024 - £13,938) giving a deficit of £11,525.56 (2024 Surplus - £12,496.60)

The new concerto that was commissioned from the leading contemporary composer, Sir James MacMillan in conjunction with Boosey and Hawkes called Where the Lugar meets the Glaisnock was premiered at the end of May 2025 in the BBC Hoddinott Hall, Cardiff and has been and will be played in a number of venues in the UK and abroad and will further develop and maintain public education in the art of music and in particular, the euphonium.

The purpose of the Euphonium Foundation is to promote improve, develop and maintain public education in and appreciation of the art and science of music and specifically in the art of playing the euphonium by the presentation of concerts, recitals, competitions, meetings, lectures, seminars, training courses and by the commissioning of new works of high quality for the euphonium and any other related activities.

The charity is controlled by its governing document, the constitution of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation whose only voting members are its charity trustees.

The trustees confirm that they have complied with the requirements of section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

The income for the year totalled £26,434.60 (2023 - £0) with costs of £13,938 (2023 - £0) giving a surplus of £12,496.60 (2023 - £0)

The Euphonium Foundation UK, in collaboration with the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama and Besson, provided our first in-person education event for euphonium players of all abilities. The event was free and very well received with 42 attendees. The charity welcomed euphonium luminaries, David Childs, Robert Childs and Steven Mead to lead a day of fun music making and educational classes, which culminated in an informal performance featuring participants, artists and the RWCMD Euphonium Ensemble.

Our new website also now includes several free training videos that anyone can access. These euphonium master class videos feature our Artistic Director, David Childs demonstrating how to improve playing abilities.

A new concerto was commissioned and a leading contemporary composer, Sir James MacMillan in conjunction with Boosey and Hawkes accepted the commission. This exciting new work will be premiered in 2025 and then played in a number of venues in the UK and abroad and will further develop and maintain public education in the art of music and in particular, the euphonium.
